The Wellers are finishing the season with some strong performances and after putting four past their opponents the previous Saturday, they looked for a similar result against Worsbrough Bridge in the local derby.

Charlie Preston, the Worsbrough keeper, had played against the Wellers and impressed for Ollerton Town, and dazzled again starting on nine minutes when Jason Paling's ball was flicked onto Eddie Agnew who crossed to find Morgan James whose shot was pushed wide.

Another save came two minutes later, but Preston could do nothing to stop the ball on 17 minutes.

A superb pass by Craig Nelthorpe in the middle of the pitch found Rhys Plater free on the right wing. After a couple of touches a perfect cross found Agnew at the far post and was free to volley in the club's 100th league goal of the season and his 15th.

Just five minutes later the lead was doubled after Juninho Blake fouled James just inside the Worsbrough half and received the first yellow card of the game. After quick treatment given, the free kick was floated into the box where blocked shots from Plater and Josh Lindley eventually saw the ball hit into the bottom corner by James for his first for the club.

Worsbrough's best chance of the game came on 28 minutes as a free kick from the left wing was headed onto the crossbar and cleared away.

Plater had a great opportunity to make it 3-0 on 37 minutes after receiving the ball from Owen Sykes down the left, but was once again thwarted by Preston.

The final action of the first half did see the third goal go in with Sykes involved once again. The left back's cross found Agnew who set-up Jordan Kershaw on the edge of the box whose driven effort was too powerful for Preston.

The visitors gave it their all at the start of the season half, however it was the Wellers who had the chance to extend their lead ten minutes in. Kershaw was fouled in the penalty area by Dempsey Smith and a penalty given.

In the game against Ollerton where Preston played he saved a second half Kershaw penalty with a save to his left...on this occasion he saved the penalty from Kershaw again - this time with a save to his right!

The keeper denied the Wellers once again on 65 minutes as Kershaw and Agnew combined, but were rebuffed with the shot.

A fourth goal finally came with just over a quarter of an hour remaining as a delivery from the right by James found Agnew highest of all and able to head in his second.

There was to be no hat-trick for the club's joint top goal scorer for the season as Agnew was replaced in the final five minutes for 16 year old James Smith, making his third cameo appearance since his birthday.

A final cherry on the cake was placed on 90 minutes as Plater's cross from the right found sub Danny Youel's shot from point blank range was deflected into the net off Preston and a Worsbrough defender to give the midfielder his first goal for the club.

The history of Parkgate Football Club is inextricably linked to the Steelworks which form such an impressive backdrop to their Green Lane home.

Operations at the Park Gate Iron and Steel Company started in 1823, and just two years after the Iron and Steel Act created the British Steel Corporation (1967), the club was formed from Parkgate's Wire Department in 1969, managed by current Chairman Albert Dudill. They joined the Sheffield and Hallamshire County FC Senior League in 1970 and the Yorkshire League as BSC Parkgate FC in 1973. The original Park Gate Works closed in 1976, two years after Electric Arc, scrap-based steelmaking started at Aldwarke; the plant becoming-and remaining- one of the UK's biggest recyclers.

Dave Bassett brought a strong Sheffield United team for the official switch-on of the club's floodlights in 1992 and in 1998 the narrowly lost the Final of the S&H Senior Cup to Emley and finished fourth in NCEL Division One.

In 1999, the steelworks came under the control of Corus Group PLC and the Steelmen began a successful period which culminated in promotion to the NCEL Premier Division in 2006/7 with the club winning the Wilkinson Sword Trophy in the same season.

In 2007/8 - around the time that Tata Steel acquired Corus Group - the club reached the semi-finals of the NCEL League Cup and the County Senior Cup.

Between 2010 and 2012 the club enjoyed

another successful period, finishing second in the NCEL Premier League and enjoying a fine run in the FA Vase.

More recent years have been difficult for the Steelmen, culminating in relegation after a frustrating 2017-8 campaign.

The Steelworks enjoyed a revival - under new owners Liberty Steel Group who acquired the facilities in 2017.

During the summer of 2017, the club developed a new youth structure introducing an Under 18's team and an U17's squad. Each team progressed over the years into U21's.

The Club announced during the summer of 2020, that they would be forming a brand-new Reserve team which will compete in the County Season FL Division Two.

After six games, a loss in the FA Cup and FA Vase, manager Billy Fox resigned and Parkgate appointed ex-player Andy Dawson as Manager, Lee Whitehead as his assistant and Ben Starosta as coach/player. The new Management team guided the Steelmen to 19 League wins and an impressive eighth place at the end of the 2018/9 season.

Dawson and Whitehead stayed until July 2022 when they were approached by Maltby Main and accepting their offer taking all the players with them, which put the Steelmen on the brink of having to resign from the League.

Having survived the 2022/2023 season the dugout now houses former Maltby Main boss Scott Mason, with his Assistants Keelan Hall and Jimmy Ghaichem.

Supporters must not take glass containers outside of the clubhouse, nor will alcohol be permitted to be brought into the ground.

Fireworks, flares, smoke canisters, knives, bottles, cans, poles and any article that might be used as a weapon and/or compromise public safety are not permitted within the Recreation Ground.
